

CALL TO ORDER

Mayor Krause called the meeting to order at 3:42 p.m.

ROLL CALL

Councilmember Gabino Aguirre, Councilmember John T. Procter, and Mayor Mary Ann Krause responded to roll call. Acting City Manager Stephen R. Stuart, Assistant City Attorney Bradley E. Wohlenberg, and City Clerk Josie G. Herrera were also present. Councilmember Ray C. Luna and Vice Mayor Richard C. Cook were not present.

PUBLIC COMMENT

There was no Public Comment.

ORDER OF BUSINESS

A. Tour of Rain-damaged Areas in and around the City of Santa Paula

The City Council toured the following rain-damaged areas. Public participation was invited.

Santa Paula Creek south of the freeway (SR 126). Public Works Director/City Engineer Clifford G. Finley noted that the storm brought in 13 feet of sediment and rock into the channel. He also noted that the U. S. Army Corps of Engineers would be issuing an emergency contract for the removal of material.

Santa Paula Creek north of The Oaks Neighborhood. Public Works Director/City Engineer Clifford G. Finley noted the damage to the U. S. Army Corps of Engineers' project.

Santa Paula Creek in the Mupu School (Forest Ranch) area. Acting City Manager Stephen R. Stuart noted that the creek banks had widened 70 to 100 feet in this area.

Highway 150 and the Harvey Diversion. Public Works Director/City Engineer Clifford G. Finley noted that the City's water main broke across the river and that the City would do an emergency design to repair the pipe bridge. He also noted that the City is working with the Department of Fish and Game to facilitate repairs to the fish ladder.

Highway 150 to Sulphur Mountain area. Staff pointed out the damage to the highway and noted that Caltrans estimates that repairs would be completed in September.

Councilmember Aguirre and City Clerk Herrera departed from the meeting at 5:10 p.m. There was no longer a quorum of the City Council. The remaining Councilmembers toured Adams Barranca at Telegraph Road and the Santa Paula Airport.
