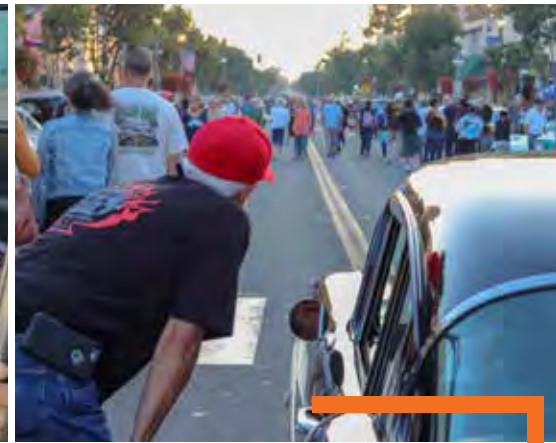

At the City Council meeting on September 5th, the names of the [12 applicants](#) that applied for the City

Council appointed position were publicly announced (due to the resignation of Councilmember Martin Hernandez on 7/31/18). City Council asked staff to return on September 19th with options for the appointment of the vacant council seat. The Council has decided to interview all 12 applicants on September 24th at a Special Council meeting to begin at 6 pm. On September 26th, another Special Council meeting will convene at 6 pm, where Council will interview four finalists and select one of them to fill the vacant council seat. The exact details of the selection process will be discussed and considered at the September 19th Council meeting.

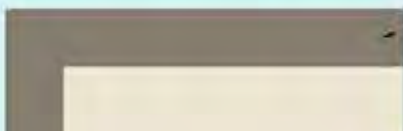

At the August 28, 2018 Planning Commission meeting Planning Commissioner Fred Robinson submitted his resignation. Mr. Robinson was presented a proclamation from the City and was recognized for more than a decade of service to the City of Santa Paula where he has served as a Planning Commissioner, a Councilmember and Mayor. The five member Planning Commission will have two vacancies in October, with Elysa Vasquez' term expiring and Commissioner Robinson's resignation. The City will be accepting applications to fill these positions (until filled).



On August 28th, the Planning Commission approved construction of a new two-story, single-family residence with an attached garage, screened porch, and deck on Montclair Place.
