The Santa Paula Police Department is seeking motivated, community-minded individuals interested in becoming Reserve Police Officers.

Santa Paula Reserve Officers are an important component of our city's public safety mission. It is an ideal place to start a law enforcement career as a reserve officer and later become a regular, full-time officer or a great place to be a long-term professional reserve peace officer.

Our Reserve Officers work varying assignments including:

- ✧ Regular Uniform Patrol
- ✧ Two-Man Reserve Backup Car
- ✧ Bicycle Patrol
- ✧ Special Enforcement Detail (SED)
- ✧ Special Response Team (SRT)

Santa Paula also has a POST Level I program. Our academy-complete reserve officers coupled with formal field training are deployed in all regular officer assignments and carry 24-hour peace officer status.

Reserve officers are furnished with all safety gear and basic equipment. There is a quarterly stipend to help offset the cost of uniforms and optional equipment.

Recruitment is continuous. Applicants must be enrolled in a POST Level II or Level I academy or have completed the academy within the last three years. Lateral Reserve Officers are welcome to apply.
