OWNER BUILDER DECLARATION

I hereby affirm that I am exempt from the Contractor's License Law for the following reason (Sec. 7031.5 Business and Professions Code). Any city or county which requires a permit to construct, alter, improve, demolish, or repair any structure prior to its occurrence, also requires the applicant for such permit to file a signed statement that he is licensed pursuant to the provisions of the Contractor's License Law (Chapter 9 commencing with Section 7000) of Division 3 of the Business and Professions Code) or that he is exempt therefrom and the basis for the alleged exemption. Any violation of Section 7031.5 by any applicant for a permit subjects the applicant to a civil penalty of not more than five hundred dollars (\$500):

- I, as owner of property, or my employees with wages as their sole compensation, will do the work, and the structure is not intended or offered for sale (Sec. 7044, Business and Professions Code: The Contractor's License law does not apply to an owner of property who builds or improves thereon, and who does such work himself or through his own employees provided that such improvements are not intended or offered for sale. If, however, the building or improvement is sold within one year of completion, the owner builder will have the burden of proving that he did not build or improve for the purpose of sale).
- I, as owner of the property, am exclusively contracting with licensed contractors to construct the project (Sec.7044, Business and Professions Code: The Contractor's License Law does not apply to an owner of property who builds or improve thereon, and who contracts for such projects with a contractor(s) licensed pursuant to the Contractor's License Law.)

I understand that the validation of this permit shall not be held to permit or to be an approval of the violation of any applicable provision of law. I understand that no street may be closed unless at least 24-hour notice has been given to the City of Santa Paula Fire Department, Police Department and Public Works Department and that it shall be the permittee's responsibility alone to notify said departments. I understand that all work performed under this permit shall conform to the standards established by the City Engineer. I hereby warrant all pavement repairs against failure or subsidence for a period of five (5) years from the date of completion thereof. I declare that:

- No excavation will exceed 5 feet in depth
- Excavation will exceed 5 feet in depth. Cal-OSHA permit is required.*
- Tunnel excavation will be required. Cal-OSHA permit is required.*
