

**NOTICE REGARDING BOARDS, COMMITTEES
AND COMMISSION APPOINTMENTS
SCHEDULED VACANCY NOTICE**

The City of Santa Paula is asking all interested individuals to apply for positions on several boards, commissions, and committees. Applicants must be residents of the City of Santa Paula. Applications are at the City Clerk's Office located in City Hall at 970 Ventura Street. Please phone or email the City Clerk's Office at (805) 933-4208, Monday through Friday, from 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., lblanco@spcity.org for further information. **Application deadline is until filled unless otherwise noted.**

Mobile Home Rent Review Commission: There is currently one vacancy for one regular member. The Commission meets on call to consider mobile home rent increases. Applicants must be and remain a resident of Santa Paula, and may not be a tenant of a mobile home park, nor owner of rental property. Commissioners are subject to personal disclosure under the rulings of the Fair Political Practices Commission. **Commission members will receive a stipend of \$50 for each meeting attended.** Recruitment shall remain open until vacancies are filled.

Recreation Commission: There are currently three vacancies for regular members for a three-year term and two vacancies for youth commissioners for three-year terms. The Recreation Commission is responsible for assisting the City Council in all matters pertaining to public recreation. The Recreation Commission meets on the fourth Thursday of each month at 7:30 p.m. at the Community Center, 530 W. Main Street, Santa Paula. Recruitment shall remain open until vacancies are filled.

Santa Paula Housing Authority Commission: There is currently one vacancy for a regular commissioner, for a four-year term. Commissioners are subject to personal disclosure under the rulings of the Fair Political Practices Commission, and all members will be compensated monthly for their services. **Commission members will receive a stipend of \$50 for each meeting attended.** The Santa Paula Housing Authority meets the second Thursday of each month at the Santa Paula Housing Authority offices at 15500 W. Telegraph Road, #B11, Santa Paula. Recruitment shall remain open until vacancies are filled.

Senior Advisory Committee: There are currently two vacancies for regular commissioners. Members serve two-year terms, and must be Santa Paula residents over the age of 55. This committee will act as a recommending advisory committee to the City Council on issues relating to senior activities such as park and recreational programming and classes, special programs and issues related to the Senior Center and special events for seniors. Recruitment shall remain open until vacancies are filled.
