Call to Order

Chair, Michael Schouten called the meeting to order at 5:00pm.

Roll Call

All members of the committee were present.

Approval of August 16th, 2018 Minutes

Committee member Iris Perez motioned to approve minutes, the motion was seconded by Nathan Ramos. All were in favor.

Public Comment

Councilmember Crosswhite mentioned that VCTC is considering the proposed bus routes from Isbell Middle School and the High School to the Youth Center.

Order of Business

1. Dr. Sandy Gomez

Dr. Sandy Gomez member of the Rape Crisis Center and Coalition for Family Harmony gave a presentation about the services that the organization offers youth.

2. Ad Hoc Committees

Youth Center Ad Hoc committee proposed requiring ID card in order to register for entry, business hours to be extended by an hour, and to change the requirement from age to grade. Mental Services Ad Hoc committee proposed to provide services starting

at Youth Center. Internship Ad Hoc Committee arranged a meeting with City Manager to discuss possible internship opportunities with the city but was cancelled due to weather and will update next meeting.

3. Homeless Percentages

There was no information to be provided at the meeting and will be on the agenda for the April 11th meeting.

4. Presentation by Laura Espinoza

Laura Espinoza gave a presentation on the status of the Santa Clara Valle Education Center. She also provided the SCL Higher Education Needs and Priorities Report which displays the criteria to open a college center.

5. Report to City Council

It was decided that the report will include survey results, funding of measure funding programs, mention all progress so far in Ad Hoc committees and present the need for a college center proposed by Laura Espinoza.

6. Youth Center Budget
