Call to Order

Chair, Michael Schouten called the meeting to order at 5:55pm.

Roll Call

Committee member, Iris Perez was not present.

Approval of April 11th, 2019 Minutes

Secretary, Daniel Navarro motioned to approve the minutes and Pedro Robles seconded. Motion passed.

Public Comment

Councilmember Crosswhite advised the committee that the Santa Paula Hospital might be closing Labor and Delivery as well as other units.

Order of Business

1. Ad Hoc Committees

Youth Center Ad Hoc Committee: Recreation Program Coordinator, Michelle Tanaka, reported on the attendance for the Youth Center.

Mental Health Ad Hoc Committee: Committee is in contact with Las Clinicas and will report back to the committee when they have more information.

Internship Ad Hoc Committee: Committee reported on plans to focus on fellowship programs rather than internships and has met with the City Manager about the matter. A fellowship is in trial for 6 weeks, the committee will report back with the findings.

2. Update on Homelessness Percentages

Councilmember Crosswhite stated that there has been an increase in unsheltered youth

between the age of 18-24 in the county. It was found that 5291 people are considered homeless county wide.

3. Update on VCTC

Chair, Michael Schouten, talked to Joddy Edington of Transition Speciality and will plan to include the Youth Center in bus route and gave options to help transport students.

4. Discuss Joint Meeting

Youth Advisory Committee plans to discuss mental health issues, community service events, and long term vision for Santa Paula.

5. Guinness World Record

The committee decided that they would try to set the Guinness record of the most lemons being held in a photograph.

6. Discuss AB705 Report

The bill AB 705 will address the gap in test scores between different ethnic groups. VC has decided to put students in transfer level English Composition, but will keep the lower classes for special cases.

7. End of the Year Report

The Committee has agreed to work on the report and discuss what it will contain.

Committee Communication

Michelle Tanaka notified the committee that summer classes have only 186 students due to the increase of price and late registration. Michael Schouten mentioned the VCTC convention that will occur on November 15th. Daniel Navarro informed the committee about the Spring Leadership Conference occurring on the 18th and 19th of June.
