Annual Self-Haulers Permit Program

Effective September 1, 2008, the City of Santa Paula is implementing its self-hauler permit program. The purpose of this program is to document and accurately track the amount of solid waste (trash, green waste and recycling) generated within the City of Santa Paula.

Here's how it works:

1. Before collecting or transporting solid waste, including recyclable solid wastes or green waste, each self-hauler and each gardener must obtain a no-cost self-haul permit from the city.
2. Each self-hauler and each gardener must report to the city, quarterly, the type, weight and destination of solid waste, including green waste and recyclable solid wastes, collected in the city and transported from the city, and present gate tickets or receipts to substantiate its disposal reports.
3. Permits will be issued annually.
